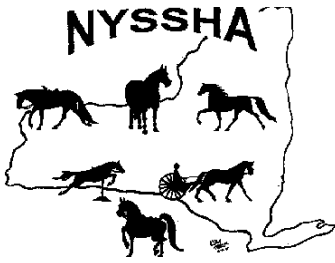

RULES & REGULATIONS - CLASSIC COUNTRY HORSE ASSOCIATION OPEN HORSE SHOW AUGUST 13-14, 2011

- 1. All classes are open to everyone meeting the criteria listed for the class - you need not be an affiliated club member to participate!** NYSSHA rules will be observed in all NYSSHA pointed classes and the Academy classes. Rulebooks are available online at www.nyssha.org or at the entry booth for inspection. For more information call **show manager Linda Voehringer 518-227- 4134 cell** or 518-885-6194 house or email ilovehorseshow@live.com. The judges decision is final and he/she has the right to dismiss any entry displaying unruliness or unsoundness. All inquires to the judge must be made thru the show office. Exhibitors or agents making inquires directly to the judge will be disqualified and no refunds issued.
- 2. Awards & Fees:** Payback vouchers must be redeemed by the end of the show - no exceptions! **\$50 Added classes** will awarded \$30 to the class winner and \$20 paid for 2nd place, and will not be sweepstaked. **NYSSHA Benefit Pleasure** classes are \$10 to enter regardless of when you enter and payback is 50% of total entry fees to winner, with the other 50% collected being donated to NYSSHA to be used to fund the Youth of the Year program. Leadline classes receive award & ribbons for all. All other classes: with 10 or more in a class payback \$20 for 1st place; with 6-9 entries in a class payback \$10 for 1st place; for classes with less than 6 entries ribbons only. **Show Champions & Reserve Champions for the weekend are also awarded!** Unless noted, Pre-entry fee is \$6/class, Post Entry fees at \$11 per class are welcomed at least 3 classes in advance. Classes must be paid for as entered or a signed blank check left at the entry booth. Office Fee of \$5 per each horse/rider combination. All horse shows renting the grounds are being charged for water usage now, so unfortunately we have to pass this fee onto the exhibitors which will be \$2 per each horse/rider. *Please do not wash your truck, camper or trailer - when you do that, we have to increase the fee the following year.* To be eligible for the **American Morgan Horse Association Open Competition Program, you must provide show management with a copy of your horses registration papers. There is no fee to be eligible!** No entry fee for Halter Championship, which is open only to the 1st & 2nd place winners of all previous In Hand classes offered.
- 3. Health Paperwork:** All entries must have a legible, current New York State (2010 or '11) coggins and (8/10 or later) rabies certificate available for inspection before back numbers are issued. **Coggins & Rabies cert. MUST be legible - if we can't read it, you will not be allowed to show - no exceptions. Must include photocopies with entries** (& have originals available for inspection on request from show management).
- 4.** Each horse-rider combination must use a separate entry form. Each entry form must have the release statement signed by the exhibitor or a parent or legal guardian if the exhibitor is under 18 years of age. Failure to wear the correct number in a class or to sign the release statement will result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees for that class, forfeiting all prize money, awards, day end and NYSSHA points.
- 5.** The show committee reserves the right to change, move, combine, add or cancel classes as warranted, decline or refuse an entry at this show without being held liable; eliminate from further competition any exhibitor or equine should the best interest of the show be served. Corrections to the prize list will be posted in the secretary's stand.
- 6. Returned Checks:** A \$50 charge for non-negotiable checks if payment is made within 7 days of notification, \$75 thereafter. This is in addition to any bank fees, collection fees and the value of the check. Participation in future events will be barred until outstanding fees are paid. Exhibitors with non-negotiable checks will have checks posted at the show as well as in future prize lists. According to the NYS General Obligations Law, Section 11-104: if your check bounces you could be liable for the face value of the check, plus two times the amount of the check, up to \$400 for a check dishonored due to insufficient funds, and up to \$750 for checks drawn on a non-existing account. Bad check writers may also face criminal penalties.
- 7. Refunds:** Pre-entry stall, class fees & water fees only, will be refunded, only if a request in writing and an authentic veterinary certificate are received by show manager no later than 6 p.m. on 8/14/11. All other fees are non-refundable. All entered classes will be charged to the exhibitor regardless of scratches. Any changes to classes, exhibitor or equine will be treated as a new entry.
- 8.** Age: **Exhibitors/Equine age** is as of January 1, 2011. All riders 13 years of age and under or competing in 13 & under classes must wear a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute Certified) Equestrian Standard per NY State Law No. VAT 1265.
- 9. Trail classes** - will be held with the main judge. If entering multiple trail classes, you must designate the class you want to count for Year End awards with show secretary at time of entry, not after the class.
- 10. ♦ symbol denotes classes that are not pointed with NYSSHA.**
Hackney classes: Hackney Horse/Ponies must be registered; their classes will be judged according to USEF class specifications.
Open Roadster Pony : Open to any breed of pony; shown to a 2 wheel bike w/stable colors at a jog/trot, road gait and speed per USEF specs.
Owner & Non-Owner to Ride Pleasure is judged same as Jack Benny Pleasure;
Hobby Horse Rookie Rewards : Open to any age rider showing in western tack and apparel. Horse/Pony of any age & breed are welcome. No stallions. Riders must never have won three first place awards in ANY mounted class (except lead line) at ANY show, unless they were the only entrant previous to this weekend. Riders ride one-handed unless horse or pony is age 5 or less. No schooling equipment. Chaps optional. Protective helmets permitted. Judging is combined horse/rider performance. Class will be judged 40% on rail work, 40% on individual pattern, and 20% on suitability of horse and rider. Pattern will be posted day of show. Winner to receive \$100 gift certificate to Hobby Horse Clothing Co.
Liberty Class (horse & pony) will be run and judged in accordance to AMHR rules, which is 1.5 minutes performance and a 2 minute catch period. Rules posted day of show. The NYSSHA pointed Miniature Horse Liberty will follow NYSSHA rules. Please provide CD with music for all entries.
- 11. Camper/Stalls** - exhibitors must post the index card on your stall/camper that the club provides. If you are found without it tagged, you will be charged double. Please comply! Anyone using a stall which has not been paid for, switching stalls, or using a stall that was not assigned to them will be charged double the normal stall fee. **You must post the index card the club provides on your stall/camper or you will be charged double.** No bedding provided. Indicate on your entry where you would like to be stabled
- 12. OTHER:** All **Dogs** on the show grounds must be leashed at all times. For safety purposes, dogs should not be near the show ring or gate areas. Owners of aggressive or nuisance dogs (as determined by show management) will be asked to remove them from the show grounds. No entry fees will be refunded. **Non-showing Equines:** Any horse on the grounds but not entered in a class will be charged \$25 for each day on the grounds. Coggins & Rabies will be checked, a release must be signed and if using a stall, stall fee must be paid.

Exhibitors may arrive after 5pm on friday August 12 and must vacate the grounds two hours after the conclusion of the last class unless other arrangements have been made with show management.

The undersigned further acknowledges the New York State Saddle Horse Association and the Classic Country Horse Association are not responsible for the conduct of other participants in such horse show and their animals and hereby waives any claim for damages against the New York State Saddle Horse Association and the Classic Country Horse Association based on an injury due to the conduct of another participant in such event or other participant's animals. **Per New York State Law No. VAT1265, all riders 13 years of age and under must wear a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute certified) Equestrian Standards. The parent/guardian who signs the release form for a rider 13 years of age and under is personally responsible for seeing that the exhibitor in their care, custody, and control obeying this law. By signing below all parties agree to follow the rules and regulations of this event and that of the affiliated organization (NYSSHA) and to pay the proper fees in full with sufficient funds. Pre-Entries must include completed entry form, legible copies of coggins & rabies certificates, and full payment of all fees at **\$6/class (except for classes 31 & 34 which are \$10 each)** and must be **postmarked by August 6, 2011**. Entries postmarked after 8/6/11 or received on show day are \$11/class. NYSSHA Benefit classes (classes 31 & 34) are \$10/class with no late fee penalty.

AWARDS/FEEES: All classes awarded ribbons to 6th place. Except for "\$50 Added" classes and Leadline, payback for 10 or more in the class \$20 to winner, for classes with 6-9 entries \$10 to winner; Leadline winners to receive special award & ribbons for all; NYSSHA Benefit classes \$10 to enter with no late entry fee charged even if you post enter; 50% of total entry fees collected goes back to winner 50% donated to NYSSHA. \$50 Added classes awarded \$30 to winner and \$20 to 2nd.
