Entry Information

Entry Fees/Paybacks :Halter, pleasure and open classes \$9 per class/\$20, \$15, \$10 & 6 ribbons (less than 10 sweepstaked)

Fitting & Showmanship and equitation classes \$7 per class/Award & 6 ribbons

All leadline classes \$5 per class/Award & ribbons

No charge for Halter Championship classes. NYSSHA Futurity classes paid through futurity committee form.

Post Entries: There will be a \$5.00 fee for post entries.

Box Stalls: Stalls will be available after 3pm on Friday. Stalls will be \$30 for the weekend. No bedding provided. Stalls in use for any purpose must be paid for. Paid tags will be issued and stalls will be checked during the show. Stalls found in use must be paid for immediately. Do not stable your horse until you refer to the stabling chart provided by the show committee. Stalls will be assigned by the show and are **NOT** first come, first serve. If you are found in the incorrect stall from which you are assigned you will be made to move.

Grounds Fee: A \$15 grounds fee will be charged for all unstabled horses. This fee is good for the whole weekends.

Camper Hook-ups: Hook-ups will be available on a first come/first serve basis for \$20/night. Please pay for hook-up and obtain paid tag before hooking your camper up to utilities. Campers found hooked up without payment will be charged double.

Office Fee: One back number per horse will be issued. A \$5.00 office fee will be charged per back number. Back numbers will not be released until all health paperwork is in order and valid release signatures are on file for each exhibitor using that number. Failure to wear the correct number or to sign the release will result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees.

Rules and Regulations: Please read carefully, no refunds will be issued due to failure to follow or understand.

1. Please refer to the NYSSHA rulebook regarding eligibility in the different divisions. It is the entrants' responsibility to know these rules and enter the correct classes.
2. Health paperwork: All horses on the show grounds must have a legible, current (2009-2010) coggins and a (9/09 or later) rabies certificate available for inspection.
3. NYSSHA rules will be observed. Rule books will be available at the entry booth for inspection, or visit www.NYSSHA.org for complete rules.
4. The show committee reserves the right to change, move, add or cancel classes as warranted.
5. Classes must be paid for as entered or a blank check left at the entry booth. Pre-paid fees will be refunded only if a request in writing and a veterinary certificate are received by October 2, 2010.
6. Trail classes will be held on the outside course with a separate judge during a set time frame. Exhibitors will be responsible for completing the course within the set amount of time or they will forfeit their entry fees.
7. Over Fences Classes: It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be schooled prior to their classes.
8. Halter Championships: The first and second place winners of Huntseat, Saddleseat, Western, Mini, and pony will be invited back for their respective championship classes, stallions are not eligible for these championships. Class 43 Overall Halter Championship will invite back the first place winners of classes, 17,18,19,20,22,23,25,27,29,30,31,34,35,38,39,and 40, to declare the overall halter championship (stallions are permitted in this class).
9. All dogs on the show grounds must be leashed at all times. If a dog is found to be unleashed, the owner and the dog may be asked to leave the fairgrounds. For safety purposes, dogs should not be near the show ring or gate areas. Owners of aggressive or nuisance dogs will be asked to remove them from the show grounds. No entry fees will be refunded.

The undersigned further acknowledges the NEW YORK STATE SADDLE HORSE ASSOCIATION are not responsible for the conduct of other participants in such horse show and their animals and hereby waives any claim for damages against the NEW YORK STATE SADDLE HORSE ASSOCIATION on an injury due to the conduct of another participant in such event or other participant's animal.
Per New York State Law No. VAT1265, all riders 13 years of age and under must wear a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute certified) Equestrian Standards. The parent/guardian who signs the release form for a rider 13 years of age and under is personally responsible for seeing that the exhibitor in their care, custody, and control to obeying this law.

To avoid the post-entry fee, mail your completed entry form (including all release signatures) readable coggins (dated 2009 or 2010) & rabies (dated September 2009 or later) for each horse with at least one class entry for each horse rider combination. You will not be charged for any classes entered if scratched at least 3 classes prior. If you fail to pre-enter you will be charged a onetime fee of \$5.00
A signed blank check will need to be left at the show office to insure payment of remaining fees before a back number will be released.
