2011 Adirondack Miniature Horse Club Show Rules and Regulations

1. <<<**Pre-Entry Special**>>> When you pre-enter by May 15, pay \$15 per horse/exhibitor combination toward paying the pre-entry fees for all the classes in which you would like to show. At the show you pay pre-entry prices for the classes in which you actually show. Exhibitors are responsible for paying for classes after the \$15 is used. The \$15 will be retained as an office fee if you do not attend. Jr. classes \$7, Sr. & Open classes \$9. Leadline \$5.
2. Classes are open to all equines meeting the criteria listed for the class. You do not need to be an affiliated club member to participate. Miniature horses and ponies will be measured for proper class entries unless holding a permanent height card from an appropriate established registry or 2011 NYSSHA measurement card.
3. NYSSHA rules will be observed in all NYSSHA pointed classes. Rule book will be available at entry booth or online at www.nyssha.org. AMHC rules to apply for all other classes and AMHC rules will be available at entry booth or online at www.adkminiclub.com. To be eligible for AMHC Year End Awards you must be a current member of AMHC at the time of the show you wish pointed.
4. The show committee reserves the right to change, move, add, combine, or cancel classes as warranted.
5. All dogs on the show grounds must be leashed at all times. If a dog is found to be unleashed or considered to be a nuisance, the owner and dog may be asked to leave the show grounds. Dogs should not be near the show ring and/or gate areas.
6. Each horse/exhibitor combination has its own number and separate entry form.
7. Classes must be paid as entered or a blank signed check left with the Secretary. Please enter at least 2 classes in advance. You must scratch 2 classes in advance or be charged for the class. \$1 is added to each class if you are not pre-entered. Pre-paid stall fees will be refunded only if a request in writing & a veterinary certificate are received within 10 days of show.
8. Ground driving obstacle and any driving class may not be cross-entered.
9. Liberty class entrants must provide music on CD or tape, cued to correct music if necessary. Ultimate Liberty is done in hand. Enter the ring and remove the halter, go through the obstacles without touching the horse. Baiting with treats is allowed.
10. Youth of the Year Benefit Pleasure- Open to all W/T/J/C/L, all proceeds to go to the Youth of the Year Scholarship Fund. \$ 5.00 entry
11. Each horse must have proof of current rabies vaccination and a current negative Coggins test. Please be sure that copies are legible.
12. Stabling: You may enter the show grounds any time after 4:00 PM on Friday, May 27, 2011. A "PAID STALL" card must be displayed on all occupied stalls. Any stall used for any length of time will be charged a \$30 stall fee. Stalls will be assigned by show secretary and anyone occupying an unassigned stall will be required to promptly remove bedding and clean stall.
13. Campers: Any trailer/camper or anyone hooking up to electric will be charged a \$22 camper fee. A "PAID CAMPER" card must be displayed in window of camper/trailer.
